
'I can say how I feel'

Home Reading Reminders

It is really important that your child reads each night. Reading is about more than being able to read the words clearly- it also focuses on having a deep understanding of the content read. Please can you ensure that your child reads each night and that their home reading records are returned to school daily.



The children will still get a stamp in their reading record every time they read and 10 stamps = 1 sticker on their reading card.
