Dear Parents and Carers,

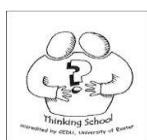
I hope you have all had a lovely weekend. Congratulations to any children and families who took part in the Great North Run this weekend. It was lovely to see so many children on Zoom today. I understand that the trust shall be contacting you regarding a building, very soon. This letter is to confirm the arrangements for face-to-face teaching this week.

Community Centre

- **Tuesday (Years 1 – 3) and Friday (Years 4 – 6)** between 8:45am and 9.00am to the main entrance (at the front of the centre) where a member of staff shall greet them.
- Please can the children be provided with a packed lunch and wear their full school uniform.
- Children should be collected at 3.30pm from the front entrance.
- Year 5/6 children can walk to and from the community centre – parents have been sent a link to complete this online.
- Children must bring their home learning packs with them. Stationary shall be provided at the community centre.
- If your child has a medical need, all medication (including inhalers) must be brought to the community centre. We do not have access to any inhalers or other medication that could have been left in school at the end of the summer term.

Nursery Building

- **Reception (Wed, Thurs, Fri morning)** to meet at St Benet's Nursery between 8:45am and 9.00am for a half-day session. Reception children are to be collected at 12pm.
- **Nursery (Wed, Thurs, Fri afternoon)** to meet at St Benet's Nursery between 1.00pm and 3.00pm for a Stay and Play session. Parents are welcome to stay with their child or they can drop them off and pick them up at 3pm.
- Children will access the Nursery building through the pedestrian gate via the main car park. A member of staff will be there to greet you and bring the children into the building.
- There are still workers on site following the summer building works. There shall be some areas completely out of bounds and fenced off.



- Children must wear their full school uniform and bring their home learning packs with them.
- If your child has a medical need, all medication (including inhalers) must be brought to the community centre. We do not have access to any inhalers or other medication that could have been left in school at the end of the summer term.

Live lessons shall continue to be provided on the days that face-to-face teaching does not take place. Please continue to contact us, if we can assist in anyway.
